Do you have a daughter who would like to pitch in the upcoming MURA rec softball season? It is difficult to teach young players to pitch during the season and most coaches don't have the time or expertise to teach young players everything they need to know to get started with the solid fundamentals they need to become successful pitchers. This clinic offers an opportunity for aspiring pitchers to gain knowledge, experience, and confidence going into the season.

How do we sign up?

How does the clinic work?

Pitchers in groups of 3-5 will work through drills and exercises led by an experienced instructor. Pitchers should bring \$20 in cash to each session. This money goes to pay the instructor and MURA does not receive any portion of your payment. MURA organizes this clinic in conjunction with the High School softball program for the benefit of Milton-Union softball in general.
